

## Job Summary

Attention bilingual mental health professionals!

Are you fluent in Spanish and hold a master's degree in social work, Psychology, or Counseling? Have you earned your Associate or are licensed with the California Board of Behavioral Sciences (BBS)? If so, we have an exciting opportunity for you to join our dynamic team as a **Part-Time Bilingual (Spanish) Clinical Therapist** for our Wraparound Services Program.

As a **Part-Time Bilingual Clinical Therapist** for our Wraparound program, you will deliver culturally responsive services and lead a collaborative planning process for youth and families who are referred to through Child Welfare, Juvenile Probation, or County Behavioral Health departments.

Services will be provided exclusively in the community: in families' homes, foster homes, schools, other community locations, etc. for youth who could require being placed in out of home care or are stepping down from a higher level of care.

The primary role is to ensure a sustainable network of unpaid supports (i.e., extended family, mentors, teachers, coaches) are working together toward stability for the youth and family.

## The Program

Contra Costa Youth Service Bureau offers "Wraparound" services to children and youth susceptible to placement, and to their families. The Wraparound programs are strengths-based, family-driven, flexible, and creative, with the goal of helping the family develop the skills and supports to prevent or reduce the possibility of out-of-home placement of their child. A family-based team addresses the needs of the entire family, not just the child of focus. This family-based team consists of family members, Contra Costa Youth Service Bureau's Therapists, Support Counselors, Family Partners, Facilitators, and other community members who have an important role in the family.

## ABOUT CONTRA COSTA YOUTH SERVICE BUREAU

**Contra Costa Youth Service Bureau** is committed to promoting and providing family-centered services to targeted children and youth ages 6 to 21 that support the whole person and their families in Contra Costa County. The agency was founded in 1984 by the West Contra Costa Consortium for Children and the Contra Costa County Probation Department. The Bureau was formally established as a community-based non-profit agency in 1985. The Bureau is guided by, and shares with our Kinship Care Support Program the following core values: coordination of services, service integration for all families, implementation of both intervention and prevention supports, and the delivery of clinically and culturally sound services

Our programs are deeply engaged in conversations and training on Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion to bring equity and justice to the youth and families we serve.

## The Role:

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This role requires a clinician who is skilled in trauma-informed care and can provide support in addressing complex emotional needs. The candidate will also be responsible for learning and adhering to EPSDT (Early and Periodic Screening, Diagnostic, and Treatment) billing requirements and managing daily billing tasks.

### **Key Responsibilities:**

- Develop and implement treatment plans tailored to each client's specific needs.
- Work collaboratively with families, schools, and other community resources to support clients' mental health and emotional development.
- Maintain thorough documentation of client progress and therapeutic interventions.
- Become familiar with EPSDT billing processes and complete accurate billing documentation daily.
- Utilize trauma-informed and culturally responsive practices in all aspects of client care.
- Participate in monthly utilization reviews with other clinicians to ensure compliance and appropriateness of care.

### **Qualifications:**

- Master's degree in social work/psychology/counseling (**required**)
  - **Registered with California BBS:** ASW, AMFT, APCC, OR full licensed
- **Bilingual Spanish/English required**
- Flexible schedule with ability to work some evenings and weekends
- Must be at least 21 years of age
- Own vehicle, Valid California driver's license and insurability with Contra Costa Youth Service Bureau's automobile policy
- TB test clearance, fingerprinting clearance, and any other state/federal licensing or certification requirements

### **Preferred Qualifications**

- Previous experience with EPSDT billing or willingness to learn quickly
- Experience working with youth in out-of-home care
- Strong organizational and writing skills
